# PATH Intl. Registered Level Instructor Workshop August 17-19, 2018

This 2½ day comprehensive workshop will enhance the knowledge base of therapeutic riding instructors and is a <u>prerequisite for the PATH Intl. Registered Instructor Certification</u>. The workshop is also useful for individuals seeking to learn more about the field but who are not yet ready to complete the certification process. Come spend valuable time with colleagues in the field of equine assisted activities and therapies. This is a great opportunity to learn and share techniques in a warm and welcoming teaching environment. *PATH Intl. membership required.* 

# PATH Intl. Registered Level Instructor Certification: Sunday Afternoon, August 19 and all day Monday, August 20, 2018

The Certification is open to 8 participants who have completed the PATH Intl. Instructor Workshop (during this offering or at a previous workshop) along with all other certification criteria (see details on Phase I and II). **The riding tests will be given on the afternoon of August 19**<sup>th</sup> and the Certification candidates will draw their teaching assignments for testing held on the 20th. With successful completion of the Certification, participants become PATH Intl. Registered Level Instructors.

**Certification Candidates** are registered on a first come-first served basis. Space is limited to 8 so please register early. Submit your Certification Application and all the completed paperwork along with your registration. Incomplete applications cannot be accepted.

### **PATH Intl. Registered Level Instructor Certification Process**

In order to become a **PATH Intl. Registered Level Instructor**, you must successfully complete **Phase I and II** of the certification process. ### **Phase I** (PATH Intl.)

Upon submission of your Registered Instructor Certification **Application Form** to the PATH Intl. office, you will officially enter into **Phase I** (requires a \$87 application fee, copies of current CPR and First Aid certification cards and PATH Intl. membership number). PATH Intl. will email you a Phase I Packet. This packet includes access to the following on-line components:

- Online Standards Course and Exam
- Instructor Self-Study Course and Exam
- Online Pre-Certification Self-Assessment Exam

**NOTE:** You will have <u>six months</u> to complete Phase I. Please note the Standards and the Instructor Self-Study courses both have 60 day time frames once you log on. Upon successful completion of Phase I, you will become an Instructor-In-Training and receive a letter from PATH Intl. confirming this status. You may retain this Instructor-In-Training designation for twelve months from the date of your Confirmation Letter.

## Phase II (Riding To The Top)

Within <u>12 months</u> of finishing Phase I, you must **complete all the components of Phase II.** These components are:

- Completion of **25 hours of practice teaching mounted therapeutic riding lessons** under the guidance of a PATH Intl. Certified Instructor
- Attendance at a Registered Instructor On-Site Workshop prior to the Certification evaluations
- Completion of a Registered Instructor On-Site Certification
